

• 8 states

National Hemophilia Program Coordinating Center (NHPCC)

- American Thrombosis and Hemostasis Network (ATHN)
 - ► Help to standardize bleeding disorder care nationwide
 - Establish national best practices for bleeding disorder care
 - Evaluate programs

SRHN- Southeast Regional Hemophilia Network

- Under HRSA there are 8 Regional Hemophilia Networks
 - ▶ 8 states are in the SRHN
 - ► GA

 - MS
 - ► NC
 - ► SC
 - ► TN
 - ► KY


What is so important about MCHB?

- ► MCHB allows an HTC to register with the Office of Pharmacy Affairs as a 340B program.
- Money for hemophilia and bleeding disorders programs and services
- ► Without 340B funding:
 - Generally speaking, HTC's would not exist in current form


